I. Approval of Minutes from January 16th meeting
Tan moves to approve minutes. Moore-Steward seconds. Minutes approved.

II. Budget Report

Contreras reports on the budget. Few suggested changes in some spelling errors as well as dates of events. Contreras will update the budget accordingly and have an updated report at the next meeting.

III. Subcommittee Reports

a. Event Funding Requests

The committee discusses three requests that came from the History Department as well as one from the Ethnic Studies Student Organization. In regards to the three requests that came from the History Department, the committee decides to send the requests back and have Jeremy Murray resubmit a request for the entire Modern China Lecture Series instead of separating the lectures. The committee agrees that they will table the vote on the request until the resubmitted form is received.

In regards to the request from the Ethnic Studies Student Organization, the committee decides to have the organization provide more clarification to the event and have them resubmit a request. The committee decides to table this request.

b. Conversations on Diversity

Tan suggests to inquire with the speakers if they have any dietary restrictions so we can make accommodations accordingly. Tan reports that the diversity webpage will house the Symposium on Race page or possibly the registration page for the event. Collins suggests to have an archive of past conversations on diversity events. She also suggests hiring someone on campus to run the website since it has so much that needs upkeep. Contreras suggests maybe a grad student. Collins requests that this be put on the next UDC agenda. Murillo-Moyeda suggests to put the diversity training link on the webpage as well. Tan says it is already on there and he reminds the committee to make sure they are refreshing the page when they go back to visit it.

f. Symposium on Race Joint Committee

Zuniga reports that the set-up/layout is done, two presenters have been confirmed and they are still waiting on two others. He adds that the save the dates will be ready soon. Evans-Carthen adds that Zuniga is working on the registration page.

Texeira requests to put changing the guidelines to limit the number of requests submitted per department for event funding requests on the next UDC agenda.
