CCI RECOMMENDATIONS

Remain Active Status

The Center for the Advancement of Second Language Acquisition (CASLA) has had limited activity related due pandemic era challenges (2019 – 2022), as noted by the Director. However, the CASLA, with a mission to promote and disseminate second language in the Inland Empire, has planned activities that are well connected to its purpose. We encourage the CASLA to spend the current funds described in the Cover Memo to initiate programs that have been delayed.

6.C.1 – The success of the Ancillary Unit in meeting the goals and objectives outlines in the original proposal:

The CASLA has demonstrated some success in meeting its goals and objectives. The workshop related to Second Language Acquisition is well aligned with its mission to improve second language teaching and pedagogy. This is an important resource for the Inland Empire community, and we encourage the CASLA to continue doing great work.

6.C.2 – The effective use of all internal University support

The CASLA has noted no plans to pursue internal funding at this time and a positive balance of funds (\$3,720 in Philanthropic Gift Fund; \$5,138 in State Trust Fund). We encourage the CASLA to spend down these funds as appropriate for the planned activities listed.

6.C.3 – The success of obtaining external support and the use of that support

The CASLA has noted no plans to pursue external funding currently (see note on positive funds from above).
