Presenting: Long-Term Consequences of Early Exposure to Methylphenidate

Dr. Cynthia Crawford received her bachelor's degree from Washington University in St. Louis and her masters and doctoral degrees from the University of Kentucky. Cynthia completed postdoctoral fellowships in the Department of Psychiatry at University of California, San Francisco, and the University of California, Los Angeles. Cynthia joined the psychology department at CSUSB in 1996. Her research has focused primarily on the biological bases of addiction and the long-term effects of psychostimulant drugs. Cynthia has published over 65 research articles and has received several federal grants from the National Institute of Health.
