Task Force Hears Students

The task force investi-gating the Office of Services to Students with Disabilities, or SSD, met with concerned

students last week.

Many students report
they are not receiveing their services. Some also speak of gross mistreatment perpe-trated by SSD staff and man-

agement.

The SSD office states that "The mission of the SSD office is to increase retention for students with disabilities by ensuring equitable treatment and equal access to all academic programs and facilities at

The task force said they The task force said they will "dispassionately" investigate the students charges. They do not intend to audit the concerns of individual students. They are investigating whether the SSD office is in compliance with state regulations. Students spoke of their concerns and issues from personal experience, in respect of their individual situations and needs. A visually impaired student related a incident where a SSD staff

President Karnig held a Budget

Council Presentation this Friday.

The focus of the presentation was
California State University San
Bernardino's general fund budget
for the 2003 thru 2004, and 2004

thru 2005 fiscal year.

During the 2003-2004 fiscal year CSUSB is looking at a budget reduction of over sixteen million

Broken down these reductions are a culmination of the governor's thirteen-million budget reduction, and the university's unfunded costs fits, risk management insurance and other costs.

From the sixteen million-budget

President Karnig discussed, fee increases for the 2004-2005 school year. Undergraduate students will be affected with a 10% fee increase, credential and graduate student will experience a 40% increase.

He also discussed that an estimat-

ty is facing from a lack of interna-tional students enrolling.

in the California State Universities

The governor plans to restrict the admission of unclassified post-bac-calaureate, second-degree candidates, lower division transfers, upper division transfers who have not completed the golden four four combinate of the properties and

not completed the golden four (math, english, communication, and critical thinking). There are some exceptions pro-vided in all categories for example, second-degree candidates will not be accepted unless it is from the nursing department.

Currently there is a waiting list for first time freshmen and lower division students attempting to enroll at CSUSB.

CSUSB plans to take a different oad in an attempt to offset the

budget cuts.
CSUSB plans to move summer sessions form state support to self-support, as ell as hit a target FTE mark of 800.

The University also plans to target all FTEs for the academic year with a goal not to exceed 1%.

All resident halls must be filled

All resident halls must be filled for the upcoming quarters. This is important because the University cannot afford to make \$50,000 payment on the resident halls if they are vacant. President Karnig stresses that CSUSB will maintain it's historical ratio of new incoming freshmen, transfer and graduate'post-baccalau-reate.






